Each Introduction to Rowing class is limited to 6 participants, and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. We must have an application, release form and check for \$50 before we can secure your spot in a class. The Introduction to Rowing class is two hours in length and is designed for those without any prior experience. It is mandatory for all beginners to attend the class before participating in the Learn to Row (Green Team) program.

Please note that any payments made for any PLRA program are NON REFUNDABLE.

After the Introduction to Rowing class, participants may join the Learn to Row Program (LTR) if space is available. Beginners can attend one or both practices each week. This is a 12-week program with the Introduction to Rowing class being the first week. There will be an emphasis on fundamentals so apparent progress will be slow early on, but learning to row properly will pay off in the long term. Cost for the 12 week Learn to Row program is \$300 (\$50 payment for Intro to Rowing can be applied to these dues).

The Portage Lakes Rowing Association offers rowing programs for adults (18+). All rowers must have the ability to swim 100 yards and thereafter to tread water for 4 minutes; otherwise they must wear a PFD at all times while on the water. PLRA will not share your confidential personal information with anyone (except with US Rowing and their insurance company & Craftsmen Recreation Club, Inc) unless you indicate "yes" on the above question about sharing with other members. Release of Liability / Affirmation of Swimming Ability

IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity to participate in any Portage Lakes Rowing Association (“PLRA”) activities (“Activity”), including PLRA practices, workouts, regattas and other PLRA activities, during the term 1/1/11 – 12/31/11, I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:

1. I ACKNOWLEDGE, agree and represent that I understand the nature of Rowing Activities, both on water and land based, and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity.

2. I FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a.) ROWING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death (“Risks”); (b.) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or the negligence of the Releasee named below; (c.) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

3. I AGREE AND WARRANT that I will examine and inspect each Activity in which I take part as a member of PLRA and that, if I observe any condition which I consider to be unacceptably hazardous or dangerous, I will notify the proper authority in charge of the Activity and will refuse to take part in the Activity until the condition has been corrected to my satisfaction.

4. I HEREBY RELEASE, discharge, and covenant not to sue USRowing, PLRA, their administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers and employees, other participating regatta organizers, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises, on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the Releasees herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the Releasee or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf, makes a claim against any of the Releasees, I WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, attorney fees, loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as a result of such claim, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

I also affirm that I have the ability to swim 100 yards and thereafter to tread water for 4 minutes.

I have read this agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect.
